This work included both the day-to-day operations of the school, as well as advancing the strategic priorities that the Board and HOS are together pursuing.

After interacting closely with Mr. Dyson and observing him operate highly effectively over several months and after receiving significantly positive feedback, both solicited and unsolicited, from many parents, faculty, staff and community members, it became very clear that Mr. Dyson was the HOS candidate that the Lord had been preparing for CSW all along.
